

GNC Grade Shepherding Guide for *God's Rules: Be Strong* (Daniel) ESV

Basic responsibilities after children arrive:

1. Greet each child by name/encourage them to wear their **name tag**.
2. Collect **JAM sheets** and give reward.
3. Take attendance.
4. Encourage children to write **prayer request** or praise.
5. **Memory Verse** – review last week's verse as a group 2-4 times
-- have children say in groups of 2-4 -- ask "What does it mean? What have you learned?"
6. Give out **tokens** for attendance, MV, JAM, etc.
7. Briefly review what was taught the week before thru ASK.
8. Encourage the children to use **restroom**.
9. **Pray** as a group.
10. **Do the part of the JAM sheet** suggested below.

Week 1 – Say MV Psalm 119:9-11

ASK "What is one thing you learned from the stories about David?"

JAM Older - Days 2 & 3; Younger – Color It! or Finish It!

Week 2 – Say MV Ephesians 6:10

ASK "What did God give you strength to do this week?"

JAM Older – Days 2 & 7; Younger – Color It! or Trace It!

Week 3 – Say MV James 1:5

ASK "What did God give you wisdom for this week?"

JAM Older- Days 2-5; Younger – Circle It!

Week 4 – Say MV James 1:5

ASK "What did God give you courage for this week?"

JAM Older- Day 4; Younger – Color It! or Match It!

Week 5 – Say MV 1 John 1:9

ASK "What is one thing you gave God the credit for this week?"

JAM Older- Day 5; Younger – Crack It!

Week 6 – Say MV 1 John 1:9

ASK "Have you trusted in Jesus as your Savior?"

JAM Older- Days 1-3; Younger – Any

Graduation –
